We have room this month for the Districts of five Conferences only, and hope to give the other Conferences in our next issue. So far as they go the figures are suggestive. In the Toronto Conference, Toronto East District leads the way, raising its full quota and \$3,411 to the good. Next comes Algoma and Parry Sound Districts, each raising more than its quota, with Barrie and Collingwood close behind. Toronto West Dictrict lags far in the rear, \$3,196 less than its share. In the London Conference there is not one District in the front rank, and most of them a good way behind, especially Windsor. Niagara Conference has one District—Brantford—which is over the mark, and another—Norwich—almost up. No District in the Guelph Conference has yet touched the \$250,000 line, and the same is true of the Bay of Quinte Conference, with one exception—Madoc—the latter District having crossed the boundary, with \$176 to spare.
