Dear Sir,-

It has been reported to this Department that instead of giving all the time necessary to your farm which was furnished you under the Soldier Settlement Act, that you are working for a white man on the mainland, and if you are doing so, and not properly working your own farm, this Department must ask you to change your plans and give more attention to your land.

I may remind you that your instalment of \$88.62 due last November has not been paid and I must insist on you not only meeting this payment but also making provision for your instalment due this Fall.
