I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 29th ultimo, regarding the discharge of certain Caughnawaga children from the Spanish River Industrial School.

In reply I beg to say that you may inform those parents who have applied for the discharge of their children, that the Department has decided not to discharge any of these children at present.

You might also inform Mayor Beauvais, who has applied for the discharge of a number of these pupils, of the Department's decision.

The Department has requested the Principal, Father Dugas, to return any tickets he may have received for these children.
