Rev. Sir,-

Herewith, under separate registered cover, I am sending you blue print plans of the New Lake Indian Boarding School. Externally the plans have not been altered, excepting the positions of a few doors and window frames which it was necessary to change, as those placed under eaves, could not be permitted owing to the danger of settlement.

This arrangement of the plan which has been approved, appears to be the best possible under the circumstances, and provides separate entrances and stair-cases throughout. The arrangement of dormitories is also entirely different and gives opportunity for complete observation in these and the lavatories, etc., from the staff-rooms on each floor, except the
