n a memorandum dated 30th September 1892, from he Superintendent General of Indian Affairs submitting herewith plans showing that part of the Shuswap and Okanagan Railway which passes through the Spallumcheen and Okanagan Reserves in British Columbia

The Minister states that the quantity of land required for the right of way of the said railway is 23.16 acres in the Spallumcheen Reserve and 6.11 acres in the Okanagan Reserve, and the Indian Agent for the locality has valued the land required in the former Reserve at \$25.00 an acre, and in the latter Reserve at \$35.00 an acre, and that a cheque for the full amount of compensation at that rate viz: - \$794.05 has been received from the President of the Shuswap and Okanagan Railway Company.

The Minister recommends that authority be given under Section 5, Cap: 33, 50-51 Vic: for the taking of the land above described for the purposes of the aforesaid Railway.
