A-44 Ten fifteen.

Q-45 Were any lights on in the hut when you went to bed?

A-45 No, sir, all the lights were out.

Q-46 Were you drinking beer with Adams, Boudreau and Bates? Were they in the party when you were drinking beer?

A-46 Yes, sir, I am pretty sure we were all at the table at the time.
