 Admonished 11 SEP 43 for absence without leave from 0800 hrs. 9 SEP 43 until 0600 hrs. 11 SEP 43. Total absence 46 hrs. (Open Arrest) To forfeit 2 days' pay under Art.149 FRI C(A).A.

(d) SENTENCE OF A DISTRICT COURT-MARTIAL
 C.36687 Pte. DAVIES, G.H.
 S.D.A.G. Highrs.

Tried by District Court-Martial on the 31st day of August, 1943, on a charge of Deserting His Majesty's Service and was found guilty of Absence Without Leave. He was sentenced to undergo detention for 150 days and to be put under stoppages of pay until he has made good the sum of \$14.37 in respect of the costs of apprehension and return to his corps. The Finding and Sentence were confirmed on the 10th day of September, 1943, by the Commander Camp Borden, Ontario. The sentence was duly promulgated on the 11th day of September 1943. Struck off strength and forfeited 95 days' pay under Art.149 FRI C(A).A. vide D.C. Part II No.65 para 1 (b) 2/18 MAR 43. Taken on strength on apprehension from illegal absence at 1905 hrs. 20 AUG 43 vide D.C. Part II No.199 para 1 (Appendix) 4/24 AUG 43. Under close arrest from 1905 hrs. 20 AUG 43 until 1000 hrs. 31 AUG 43. Total close arrest 10 days, 14 hrs. and 55 min. To forfeit 11 days' pay under Art.149 FRI C(A).A. Total forfeiture 161 days' pay.

C.101831 Pte. PRODEUR, L.E.
 sentenced by a Civil Power, 3 SEP 43, on a charge of Stealing an Automobile, Contrary to Section 377 of the Criminal Code of Canada, to be imprisoned in the Ontario Reformatory for one year dated from 7 AUG 43. Sentenced 3 SEP 43 on a second charge of Theft, Contrary to Section 457 (a) of the Criminal Code of Canada, to be imprisoned for one year in the Ontario Reformatory, dated from 7 AUG 43, to run concurrent with sentence of even date. In Civil Custody since 1145 hrs. 7 AUG 43. To forfeit all pay and allowances from 7 AUG 43 until completion of sentence.
