having been duly sworn, states,

On the night of 20 July 40 I, accompanied
with other members of the Prov. Coy., proceeded to an

Club. It had no fence and the enclosure and it was
in the open air. There were about 100 people there.
Most of them were playing at different table. I went
to a table where a game was in progress. There
I saw the accused. He was running the table, in my
situation. He was calling the dice. He was changing

accused was paying off the winners and taking
in the money of the losers. I saw him rolling
the dice while I was there. Then the signal went, a
black flag & whistle, and I arrested the accused. Just
as soon as the whistle blew he picked up his money
