Dear Mr. Ditchburn:

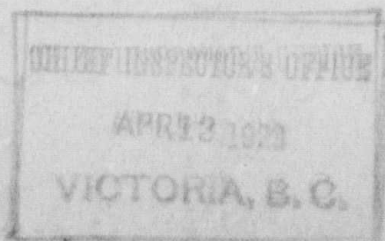
I beg to acknowledge receipt of your letter of March 24th, as numbered above, with reference to the timber amounting to 1,313,549 feet of timber cut from Toquana Reserve No.4, of the Sliammon Indians, under the license of Messrs. Peers & Anderson, and in reply thereto I beg to inform you that I have collected from Messrs. Peers & Anderson the sum of \$3293.94, in payment of the same, \$1.00 per thousand of which is being forwarded to Ottawa and the balance being retained for distribution to the Sliammon Indians.
