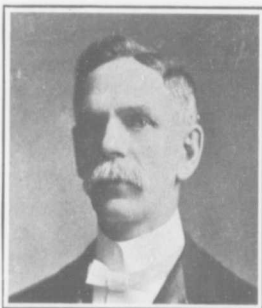


**The
Parsonage**

This is situated at 177 James St. South, and was built in 1875, and furnished by the indefatigable efforts of the Ladies' Aid Society of the Church, forming as it does a most comfortable and indispensable adjunct of the Church.

One of the Church's outside activities is seen in the Garth Street Mission, situated on the corner of Dundurn and Main streets. Taken over by special request in 1909, it continues under the care of Centenary. The following Pastors have been in charge—Rev. E. G. Sanders, A. E. Dyson, A. H. Rowe, Robert Holloway, H. S. MacDonald, E. A. Norton and Joseph Philp, M.A., B.D. Mr. Philp the present Pastor, is ably assisted by Miss A. E. Sherwood, Deaconess. The Mission property is valued at \$10,000 and has a seating capacity of 400. There are very energetic and prosperous junior and senior organizations in connection with the Mission.
