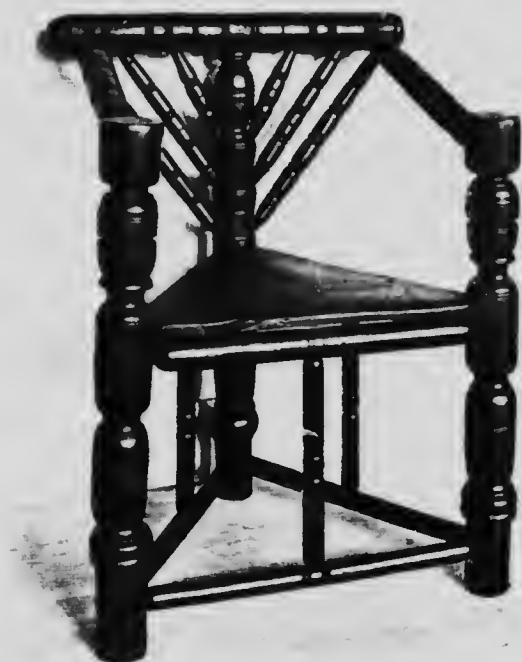




ELIZABETHAN CHAIR.
