

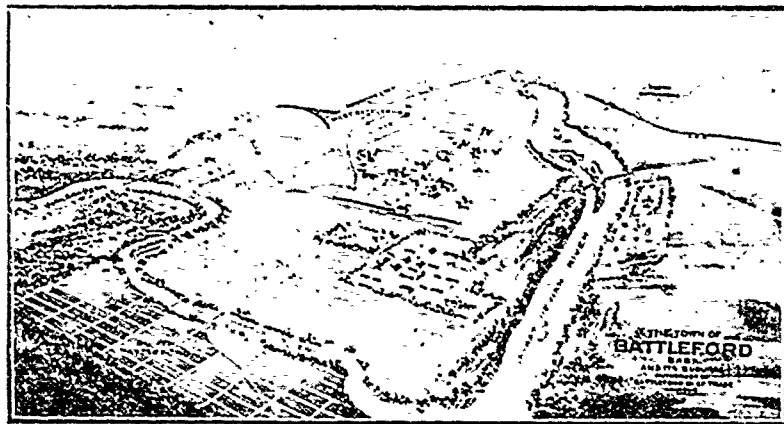
BATTLEFORD'S

BATTLEFORD WILL HAVE LOW TAX RATE FOR MANY YEARS.

The rate of Taxation for the year 1912 will be lower than that of any Town or City in the whole three Prairie Provinces. This rate will be fixed in August and by careful survey of figures now before us this year's rate cannot exceed

ELEVEN 11 MILLS

It is generally expected that the one cent (10 mills) will be quite sufficient to cover all requirements.
