“ **A**T the Provincial Parliament, begun and holden at *Quebec*, the eighth day of January, *Anno Domini* one thousand eight hundred and twenty-five, in the fifth year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord GEORGE the Fourth, by the Grace of GOD, of the United Kingdom of *Great Britain* and *Ireland*, King, Defender of the Faith, and from thence continued, by several prorogations, to the twenty-first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and twenty-six ;”
