T the Provincial Parliament, begun and holden at Quebec, the eighth day of January, Anno Domini one thousand eight hundred and twenty-five, in the fifth year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord GEORGE the Fourth, by the Grace of GOD, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ircland, King, Defender of the Faith, and from thence continued, by several prorogations, to the twenty-first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and twenty-six;"
