

## C A P. V.

An Ordinance to make good two certain sums of money therein mentioned advanced in payment of certain indispensable expenses of the Civil Government of Lower Canada, between the first day of March, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-eight, and the thirty-first day of October of the same year.

## Preamble.

**W**HEREAS it is necessary to make good two certain amounts supplied by or-  
der of His Excellency Sir John Colborne, whilst Administrator of the  
Government of this Province, and of His Excellency the Governor General thereof,  
severally and respectively, for the payment of certain indispensable expenses of the  
Civil Government of Lower Canada, between the first day of March, one thousand  
eight hundred and thirty-eight, and the thirty-first day of October, one thousand  
eight hundred and thirty-eight:—Be it therefore Ordained and Enacted, by His  
Excellency the Governor of the Province of Lower Canada, by and with the  
advice and consent of the Special Council for the affairs of the said Pro-  
vince of Lower Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of an Act of the  
Parliament of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, passed in the  
first year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, intituled, “*An Act to make tem-  
porary provision for the Government of Lower Canada;*”—And it is hereby  
Ordained and Enacted by the authority of the same, that from and out of the un-  
appropriated moneys which now are, or shall hereafter come into the hands of the  
Receiver General of this Province for the time being, there shall be taken and ap-  
plied the sum of five thousand five hundred and eighty-three pounds, nineteen  
shillings and ten pence, sterling money, to make good a like sum which was taken  
and applied for the purposes aforesaid, between the said periods, by order of His  
Excellency Sir John Colborne, and the sum of eighteen thousand one hundred and  
thirty-six pounds, seventeen shillings and six pence sterling, to make good a like  
sum, which was taken and applied for the purposes aforesaid, between the said pe-  
riods, by order of His Excellency the Governor General.

To be account-

II. And be it further Ordained and Enacted by the authority aforesaid, that the  
application of the said amount of twenty-three thousand seven hundred and twenty  
pounds, seventeen shillings and four pence sterling, shall be accounted for to Her  
Majesty, her heirs and successors, through the Lords Commissioners of Her Ma-  
jesty's
