Ordered. that if any Member have occasion to speak with another Member of this House, while the House is sitting, they shall go together below the Bar, or elfe the Speaker is to stop the business in agitation.

Bills are feldom opposed at the first reading, and are commonly committed upon Motion, at the second reading, at which time the principle is usually debated.

Ordered and declared, that no Bill fhall be read twice on the fame day. That no Committee of the whole Houfe fhall proceed on any Bill on the fame day in which the Bill is committed. That no Report fhall be received from any Committee of the whole Houfe on the fame day in which fuch Committee goes through the Bill, when any amendments are made to fuch Bill; and that no Bi-l fhall be read the third time on the fame day in which it is reported from the Committee, unless the Houfe, upon motion, fhall fee fpecial caufe for the common utility to change the fame courfe in any particular inftances.

Ordered and declared, that when the queftion hath been entirely put by the Speaker, no Member is to fpeak upon the queition before young.

Ordered, that after a queflion is put, and the Houfe hath voted, no Member shall depart out of his place, until the House hath entered upon some other business.

Ordered, that at votes, the contents do rife in their places, and the non-contents continue to fir.

Ordered, that luch Members as shall make protestation, or enter their differents to any vote of this House, as they have a right to do, without asking leave of the House, either with or without their reafons, shall cause their Protestation or differents to be entered in the Ulcrk's book on the next fitting day of this House, before the rising of the House, otherwise the same shall not be entered, and shall also fign the same before the rising of the House on the same day.
