the Aland Islands, the Bolsheviki government has decided to deny to Sweden the right to send diplomatic couriers through Russian territory.

Warned Against Siberia

Moscow, March 26.—(By the Associated Press)—The commissioner for agriculture has sent out a warning to all councils of workmen's and soldiers' delegates against emigration to Siberia, which is increasing to a noticeable extent among peasants and also workmen who have been deprived of their livelihood by the closing of mills and factories. The commissioner says there is little good land in Siberia which is available for immediate coloniza-tion, and it is very difficult under present conditions to carry out the necessary work of organization. He suggests that the peasants first take he land owners' estates.

The colonization policy of the former impedial government the ommissioner says, was meant to divert the attention of the peasants from the land problem at home, and caused the ruin of thousands who ettled in marshes or arid tracts. Tevtons At Work.
