How much bluing should be allowed to a tub of water, and what kind is best? If clothes are too blue, how can you counteract the next time? There are a number of very good bluing in the market. Indigo, of course, is the best. After the clothes are washed, add a few drops of the bluing, and if you use a liquid bluing, sufficient to make a light blue color. Take the softest fabric you have in an old handkerchief, for instance, dip in the water, wring it out, if it is not too strong, add a few drops of the bluing, and it will be the color you desire. If you use a dry bluing, dissolve it first, not more than a teaspoonful in a bowl of soft water, then stir in the bluing, and then wring out the clothes. Sprinkle dry bluing into the tub, as the clothes will be spotted; these spots will after turn into iron-rust marks.
