BLACK CAPE

BLACK CAPE, April 25.—The Atlantic and Lake Superior Railway is having quite a time, on account of washouts along the line. It is about two weeks since a through train could reach Matapedia. On Saturday the west bound train got as far as Goose Lake, a few miles west of New Richmond, when, finding several feet of water over the track, had to run back to New Richmond station. Just at that time a small bridge a short distance east of the Cascapedia River had been moved by the running water and ice. The east bound train could only get as far as Grand Cascapedia. Mill and passengers had to be taken from Grand Cascapedia with teams.
