### Shortage of Swede Turnip Seed

Swede turnip growers are urged this spring to endeavour to secure and transplant a few sound roots to produce seed for themselves and their neighbours. Owing to the abnormal conditions now prevailing there will likely be very little swede seed for planting in the spring of 1918 unless our Canadian swede turnip growers make provisions for their own supplies by growing the seed themselves. Canadian supplies of swede and most other field root and garden seed formerly came from Europe but this source is now pratically cut off. The prospects for home grown seed have been reduced by the present price of swede tur nips for food purposes, as it would
