By way of illustration the Bishop said he might aay to his washerwoman. "If gou really mean to keep straight, you bad better not touch the giv at all; better give it up atiogother.". He wha, of course, liable to the answer, "Yog have never atood over the wash tub.for many hours, or you would tell a differant tale." That was a very effective answer. Bat if he conld get a good many wasberwemen to try jt, and set them to argue with the other washorwomsn-(langh. ter)-sbe conld not make that anawer to them. In this way total abstainers were onnstantly carrying on a vely forcible argament in their own presence wherever they went.
In answer to the afsertion sometimes made, that total abstainers are rour, gloomy people, his Lordship rnid he laughed as mach as anybody did, and cortainly a great deal more than most of the drankards did. He did not at all deny that there were some really strong arguments ageinst total abstinence. For inatance, it was perfectly trae that it was a serinus thing to interfere with Christisa liberty, and if they pasbed this question no far as to use any sort of compalsion he did not think it would be right. There were argaments of that sort to which he always gives full weight; but let those who were so very anxious to preserve their Cbistian liberty, remember al ways that St. Panl warned them not to make their liberty the occasion of another man's fault-(applanse)and do their atmost in the exercise of thoir Chriatian liberty to diminish temptation. They could do much. Could they not, for insiance, do a great deal more than thes did in legislation? Would there not be a considerable diminution of temptations if the law would allow a seriona dimination it the number of prblic honses? His own little boy, six years old, walking out on Patney Common, came on a drunken man. The little liflow was very mucb sbocked, and was roady to cry; and be said to his nurse, "I should like to be king without any Parlisment. I would make the atuff a guinea a drop, and then it would be too dear for thom. to buy it." (Laughter) Could they not learn a lebson from the six-year-old? Sarely, they might egiee that children at anyrate should never be allowed to touch it at all. He greatly rejoiced in the Bands of Hope, but apart from that he thought they might do a good deal by persuading fathers and mothors to abatain from giving little cbildren what might do them terrible mischief and woald do them no posiible good. (AFplause).
