A Message was received from the Senate informing this House that the Senate had passed the following bill to which the concurrence of this House is desired:

Bill S-22, An Act to incorporate Laurentide Finance Company.—Mr. Johnson.

The said bill was deemed to have been read the first time and ordered for a second reading at the next sitting of the House, pursuant to Standing Order 103(2).

By unanimous consent, the House resumed consideration in Committee of the Whole of a certain proposed resolution to amend the National Housing Act, 1954.

## (In the Committee)

The following resolution was adopted:

Resolved,—That it is expedient to introduce a measure to amend the National Housing Act, 1954 to increase the aggregate amount of all loans in respect of which insurance policies may be issued under the Act from four billion dollars to six billion dollars; and to increase from one billion dollars to one and a half billion dollars the aggregate amount that may be paid out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the purposes specified in subsection 1 of section 22 of the said Act.

Resolution to be reported.

The said resolution was reported and concurred in.

Mr. Walker, seconded by Mr. Churchill, by leave of the House, presented Bill C-53, An Act to amend the National Housing Act, 1954, which was read the first time and ordered for a second reading at the next sitting of the House.

## (Private Bills)

Bill SD-19, An Act for the relief of Janet McMillan Sim Sinclair Kerr, was considered in Committee of the Whole, reported without amendment, read the third time, on division, and passed.

Pursuant to order made August 26, 1958, a Message was sent to the Senate to return to that House the evidence taken and the papers produced in respect of the foregoing divorce bill before the Senate Standing Committee on Divorce.
