After debate thereon, by unanimous consent, the amendment was withdrawn.

Debate was resumed on the motion of Mr. Reid, seconded by Mr. Faulkner,—That Bill C-370, An Act to amend the Electoral Boundaries Readjustment Act, be now read a third time and do pass.

After further debate, the question being put on the motion, it was agreed to.

Accordingly, the Bill was read the third time and passed.

The Order being read for the second reading and reference to the Standing Committee on Transport and Communications of Bill C-367, An Act to amend the Fort-Falls Bridge Authority Act;

Mr. Reid, seconded by Mr. Turner (London East), moved,—That the Bill be now read a second time and referred to the Standing Committee on Transport and Communications.

And the question being put on the motion, it was agreed to.
