Customs Tariff

Expansion is expected to take place in the mining of ironsands to satisfy the rising demands of domestic steel producers, as well as in the mining of molybdenite, lead, zinc and copper.

All of this should be of benefit to Canadian producers of mining machinery and other related equipment. Similar opportunities are expected in the exploration for new natural gas deposits, its extraction, treatment and transportation.

We have that expertise here, we have that ability here. I would call it six o'clock, Mr. Speaker.
