The Order of the Day being called for resuming the adjourned debate on the inquiry of the Honourable Senator McRae calling the attention of the Senate to the development of our Gold resources, and what an active programme to increase our Gold production could mean to the general prosperity of Canada, particularly in the employment of labour, the establishment of new communities and the importance of Gold in taking care of our foreign obligations, it was—

Ordered, That the said Order of the Day be postponed until to-morrow.

The Order of the Day being called for resuming the adjourned debate on the inquiry by the Honourable Senator Johnston calling the attention of the Senate to certain matters relating to the historical and constitutional position of this Honourable House, its functions and its record within the scope of the responsibilities assigned to this Honourable House under our Constitution, it was—

Ordered, That the said Order of the Day be postponed until to-morrow.

The Senate adjourned.
