I. GOD

1. *Who made you?*

God made me.

2. *Why did God make you?*

God made me to know
Him, to love Him and to
serve Him, and by that
means, to be happy with
Him for ever in heaven.

3. *What is God?*

God is a spirit, eternal,
infinitely good, all power-
ful; He sees all things.

4. *Why do you say that
God is a Spirit?*

Because God has no body.

5. *Why do you say God
is eternal?*

6. *Why do you say God
is infinitely good?*

Because all good is in God:
he is supremely good above
all things.

7. *Why do you say God
sees all things?*

Because God sees all

8. *Where is God?*

9. *Are there several
Gods?*

No, there is but one God.

10. *Are there several
persons in God?*
