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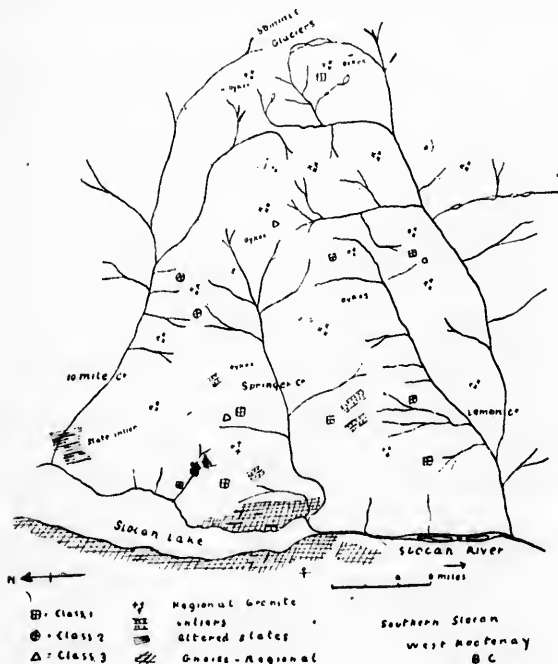
Some Ores and Rocks of Southern Slokan. 293

SOME ORES AND ROCKS OF SOUTHERN SLOKAN DIVISION, WEST KOOTENAY, BRITISH COLUMBIA.

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The section of country taken up by this paper is a part of the Slokan Mining Division of West Kootenay, British Columbia.

As may be seen from the accompanying sketch map, this particular area lies in the drainage basins of Ten



Mile, Springer and Lemon Creeks, west of the divide between Kootenay Lake and Slokan Lake and River.
