

for postage, same rates as Book postage. For the United States, 10 cents for a parcel not exceeding 8 oz. in weight. Must be prepaid.

PARCEL POST.—For places in Canada, 15 cents per 8 oz. Must be prepaid.

POST CARDS.—Post Cards for transmission between any place in Canada and any other place in Canada, or to the U. States, are issued at one cent each. Post Cards for transmission to the United Kingdom will be issued at 2 cents each.

REGISTERED LETTERS.—Letters intended to be Registered, when addressed to places in Canada, or to the United States, must be prepaid by stamp 2 cents each, in addition to the postage rate. To the United States 5 cents each, and to the United Kingdom 8 cents each. All Letters for Registration should be posted 15 minutes before the hour of closing the mails.

REGISTERED LETTER STAMPS have been issued of the denominations of 2, 5, and 8 cents, which may be obtained at the usual places.
