RESOLVES of the Quebec Branch of the AGRICULTURE SOCIETY at the Meetings of the DIRECTORS on the 31st. March, and the 4th of April, communicated to the Society at the General Meeting helds the Castle of St. Lewis on the 6th. Day of April, 1789.

## RESOLVED,

I. HAT the Agriculture Society under the Fatronage of the Right Honorable Lord Dorchester, thall confift of as many Members as may subscribe to pay a Guinea annually.

II. That confidering the great extent of the Province it will be expedie that the Society be divided into Branches; and that the Directors parties at this meeting undertake only the conduct and management of the affairs of the Society in the district of Quebec (which shall be one branch for one year;

And that the subscribers residing in the district of Montreal, and into other districts, will appoint Directors, a Secretary and a Treasurer, amanage the affairs of their respective districts as branches of the sea Society, and will communicate reciprocally their observations, withe result of the experiments that may be made in their districts the improvement of husbandry.

III. That a general meeting of the subscribers in this district shall be in on the 6th. of April next, and that a general meeting be held on a first Monday in every month of March.

IV. That the members of the Society pay their subscription moneys nually to the Treasurer at the general meeting.

V. That there be four stated terms in the year for the meetings of Directors, viz.—on the 15th. of February—10th. of June—15th. September—and 30th. of November: And when any of those days on Sunday, the meeting shall be held the next day.
