

(15). Charge into an opponent after he (opponent) has thrown the ball.

(16). Wear spiked shoes (Rubbers excepted).

(17). Persistently throw the ball out of bounds, lie on same, or in any way try to prolong the time of a game.

(18). Check an opponent's lacrosse, or attempt to knock the same out of his hands in any way, unless both players are contending for the ball.

(19). Deliberately strike another with his lacrosse or otherwise.

RULE XI.

CERTIFICATES

Sec 1. No player shall be entitled to a Certificate, nor shall a Certificate be issued to him, unless he has been a member of the club applying for same for at least 30 days, and is a bona fide resident of the City, Town or Village in which the club applying for his Certificate is situate, or within a radius of two miles thereof. Every Certificate must be forwarded to the Secretary of the Association within three days of the date thereof.

Sec 2. Every signature to a Certificate must be made in ink, signed by the player, in person, and be verified by the President and Secretary of the Club applying for the same.

Sec 3. Should any club consider a player in possession of a playing Certificate not entitled to the same, by reason of his having violated the amateur rules, or for any other cause, it shall be the duty of the said club to present their evidence to the President of the Association, who shall have the power to suspend the said Certificate. In the event of a playing Certificate being suspended, the player therein mentioned will not be allowed to take part in any match during the suspension of his Certificate under any circumstances.

Sec 4. Any Certificate used for a player other than the one for whom it was issued, shall be confiscated by the Referee and forwarded to the Secretary of the Association with a report of the facts of the case, and the player shall not be allowed to play
