God; nay more, as the living Word of the Living God: supernatural in origin; eternal in duration; inexpressible in value; infinite in scope; divine in authorship; human in penmanship; regenerative in power; infallible in authority; universal in interest; personal in application; inspired in totality.

(I would like to suggest as a great stimulus and strength to the student of the Word, two books on the Bihle hy the late Dr. Adolph Saphir, the very learned Hehrew Christian, entitled "Christ and the Scriptures," and the "Divine Unity of Scripture." "Christ and the Scriptures" is a cheap little hook, hut for its size is considered hy many to he the best ever written, on the subject. Saphir's "Divine Unity of Scripture" is really a great and scholarly work, noble in its style and suggestiveness. The man who reads them should never doubthis Bible any more.)
