SPECIAL ALLOWANCES FOR CRIPPLED TROOPS

Ottawa, Jan. 6.—A rate of allowances has been fixed by order-in-council for discharged soldiers coming from their place of residence to the military hospitals.

As the government is responsible not only for issuing of original limbs but their maintenance thru the entire lifetime of the soldier, it frequently becomes necessary for the discharged men to visit the commission's branch factory.
