BRITISH MAKE FURTHER ADVANCE IN FLANDERS CITIES DEMAND BETTER PAY AND EQUAL PENSIONS FOR SOLDIERS

HAIG TAKES NEW SLICE FROM FOE IN BELGIAN WAR

British Advance Lines 2,000 Yards, Getting Astride St. Julien Road—Throw Back Attempt To Retake Inverness Copse—French Penetrate Trenches.

London, Aug. 28.—As the result of a British attack on the Flanders front yesterday, the British lines have been advanced along a front of more than 2,000 yards, astride the St. Julien-Poelcapelle road, the war office announced today.

German attempts last night to drive back the British from their positions in the Inverness copse on the Ypres-Menin road were frustrated, and prisoners were taken from the attacking forces.

The text of the statement reads: As the result of our attack yesterday we have advanced our line, after heavy fighting, on a front of more than 2,000 yards astride the St. Julien-Poelcapelle road, and are established in further positions of the German third system in this area.

Early last night the enemy twice attacked our positions in the Inverness Copse, on the Ypres-Menin road. On both occasions he was repulsed, we securing a few prisoners.

ARTILLERY ACTIVE ON VERDUN FRONT.

Paris, Aug. 28.—The French official report on the progress of hostilities given out this afternoon refers to artillery activity on the Verdun front. It says that French troops penetrated German trenches at Butte-de-Souain and took some prisoners near Arracourt. There was considerable artillery activity on the Verdun front.

The text of the statement follows: "What promised to be a night of violent bombardments of our lines in the region of the Champagne Plateau and Arracourt was checked by the fire of our artillery. The enemy found it impossible to deliver an attack. We penetrated certain German trenches at Butte-de-Souain and we dispersed certain retreating parties of the enemy at Mont Moulin near Arracourt. We took some prisoners.

INSIGNIFICANT, IS REPORT OF ENEMY.

Berlin, Aug. 28.—via London.—The British made only insignificant gains northeast of Presenberg in their attacks on the Flanders front yesterday, army headquarters announced today. The Russians in the region east of Czernowitz have been repulsed in their attacks on the Rukina River sector, says the announcement. The Russian resistance broke down last evening on the hills northeast of Dolzok. The captures total more than 1,000 prisoners and six guns.

CHINESE GENERALS OFFER 50,000 TROOPS TO ENTENTE ALLIES

Peking, Thursday, Aug. 23 (delayed).—Generals Lo Pei Ching, Lung Chi Kwang and Ku Chin Ten, commanding 50,000 troops of Yunnan, Kwai Chong and Kwang Tung provinces, have offered forces for service in Europe. The provisional government of Yunnan and Kwang Tung have given official recognition of Peking's declaration of war against Germany, apparently having been reconciled to the government. The acting president, General Feng Kwo Chang, said the Chinese government and the southern provinces are now plainly a bloc.

Eighteen provinces have approved the project for a national council, which will be established within a fortnight. The press generally is urging China to present an undivided front to the enemy.
