CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS

ONTARIO RIFLE ASSOCIATION.

OF THE

CONSTITUTION.

1. That this Association be denominated "The Ontario Rifle Association."

2. Any person being a subscriber of \$1 per annum, shall become a member of the Association.

3. Donors of \$20 at one time to the funds of the Association, or of a prize of not less than \$40, to be competed for at the annual prize meeting, shall be entitled to be enrolled as life members of the Association.

4, Any Battalion or Rifle Association in the Province subscribing not less than \$10 annually to the funds of the Association, shall be considered as being in connection with it, and shall be entitled to a number of memberships, in the proportion of one to every half-dollar thus subscribed. Each subscribing Association is to elect from its members the persons to hold such memberships, and return their names and addresses, when elected, to the Secretary of the Association, to be registered by him one week previous to the match.

5. There shall be a Patron and Vice-Patrons named by the Council.

The Lieut.-Governor of the Province of Ontario, for the time being, shall be respectfully requested to become "Patron."

6. There shall be a President.

7. There shall be four Vice-Presidents,—one for each Military District.

1st. Four members from each of the Military Districts, who shall be elected primarily at this meeting, and hereafter at the annual meeting.
