BIG PROGRAMME OF SHIPBUILDING


Ottawa, March 13—Shipbuilding initiated in Canada by the British government through the Imperial Munitions Board is now being vigorously developed throughout the Dominion.

BRITISH GAIN MAIN DEFENCES WEST OF BAPALME

London, March 13—The official report from British headquarters in France announces the abandonment by the Germans of their main defensive system west of Bapaume on a front of three and one-half miles. The British troops drove back the German rear guard to a depth of one mile, and occupied Grevillers and Loupart Wood, bringing the advanced British forces to the former place to a scant mile and a half to the north-western outskirts of Bapaume.

North of the Ancre on the left wing, the British in this particular operation have bent back the German line on a front of about a mile east and northeast of Gommeкур and somewhat straightened out the curve extending from Essarts-Bucquoy to the region northeast of Puisieux-au-Monts.

New Record For Harbor Receipts

Annual Report of Commissioner of Harbors Shows Big Increase in Business for 1916

The annual report of Commissioner J. V. Russell, of the harbors, ferries and wharves, was submitted to the common council yesterday afternoon and showed that the exports from the city of St. John for the past year totalled the enormous sum of \$150,042,590, establishing a new record.






Maude's Cavalry Five Miles Above Bagdad

London, March 13—British cavalry from Bagdad has occupied Kazimain, on the Tigris river, five miles above Bagdad, it was officially announced today. The occupation took place on March 11. Considerable booty was taken in Bagdad. Five hundred wounded were left in the city and made prisoner by the British. Since February 25, said the official report, the Turks had been busy destroying and removing everything valuable in Bagdad. A considerable amount of booty has nevertheless fallen into the hands of the British, including large quantities of equipment, arms and ammunition.

War News In Brief

Seven lives were lost and one American placed in jeopardy in the sinking without warning, by a submarine of the German cruiser Folio, off the Irish coast on Sunday. It is officially announced that a captured German cruiser has been sighted in the Indian Ocean, and that it is now being chased by Japanese and British warships. The Norwegian steamer Lars Forstenes, bound from America for Rotterdam with a cargo for the American Relief Commission, has been sunk outside the blockade zone.
