DEBENTURES OF N. S. SELL HIGH Tender of Syndicate of Canadian and American Bankers for \$1,800,000 Accepted.

(Halifax Chronicle.) Tenders for \$1,800,000 6 per cent debentures for the Province of Nova Scotia were opened by the provincial treasurer yesterday afternoon, and the loan was most favorably received. The loan was accepted by Messrs. Macdonald, Young, Weir & Company at Toronto, a syndicate consisting of Kistner, Kistner & Company, New York; Blair & Company, Inc., New York; Stacey & Braun, Toledo; William R. Compton & Company, New York fifteen years, payable in New York at 106.173.

This price was considered very high, and the provincial authorities were being congratulated by local financial men yesterday on the fact that such terms were procurable, terms which are better than any offered on any loans obtained by any other province of the Dominion for this year. Several very interesting and significant comparisons were made when the price of this loan became known. Compared with the last loan which the province made, namely that on March 30th last, the price is exceedingly favorable. On that occasion the loan was for \$1,500,000 five-year bonds at a price of 102.978 New York, whereas the present year is on fifteen year bonds but at a rate of 106.173.

A recent Ontario loan, half of which was in Canada and half in the United States, brought 98.98 in the former country and about 99 in New York. Among all financial men the opinion was that the loan was most favorable. All Canadian, provincial and national loans are being eagerly sought by American financial houses, but Nova Scotia stands exceedingly high which may be indicated by the fact that the Western houses are bidding as well as east.

A representative of one large financial corporation at present in Halifax said, considering specially the lower rate of exchange, this was the best made for some time. Another broker who makes a close study of the American market attributed the demand for all Canadian, provincial and national securities very much to the very energetic propaganda, which bond houses of this country were putting out all over the United States.

EUROPE STILL HOLDS KEY TO PROSPERITY Common Basis of Understanding a Necessary—Curtail Armaments

In an interview given in Montreal last week President C. E. Mitchell of the National City Bank of Montreal, City of New York, stated that the great debtor and creditor nations of the world were coming together on some common basis of understanding leading to the clearing up of the complicated situation in international relations before any one country could expect a return of prosperity. He also said that waste of capital expenditure in Europe, which had studied the international situation, was probably seasonal and he emphatically expressed his opinion that the key to prosperity would continue to be held in Europe for some time.

Increased activity was observable in most lines of American trade, in the metal trades of the United States suffering from European competition, which would hold until wages were further reduced on this side. Mr. Mitchell thought the tendency of various countries to establish artificial trade barriers was another stumbling block in the way of progress, but could not see much hope of a lead to different action from the United States.

POTATOES CHEAP IN TORONTO MARKET (Toronto Globe.) The potato market remains easy with receipts of Ontario stock plentiful. Commission men were quoting prices as low as \$1.15 per bag in carlots for Ontario grown stock yesterday, while New Brunswick were quoted at \$1.25. Quotations to the retailers ranged up as high as \$1.75 per bag, there being apparently considerable high-priced stock still on the market. Two cars from the West were said to have been on the local track shipped down here on consignment, but it is difficult to see how the shipper will make much money on them at present prices. One Toronto dealer estimates that potatoes must sell at \$1.75 here to net the western shipper 60¢ per bag at home.

SHOE FACTORIES BUSY Hamilton, Oct. 31.—W. S. Duffell of the John McPherson Shoe Company stated today that during the past month there had been a considerable increase in business, and nearly all employees were wanted at once. The firm is employing more hands than it has had for months.
