The dates of the Halifax carnival week have been fixed as August 7 to August 12.

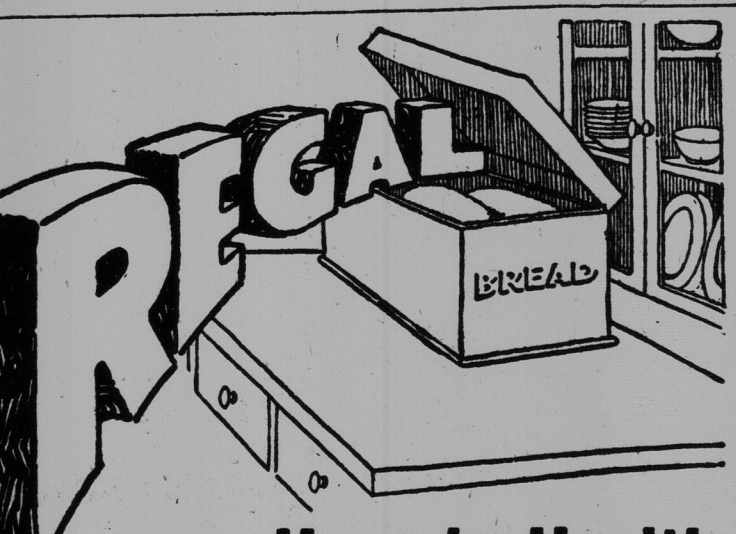
