London, July 10.—(By Canadian Press).—The fifth annual meeting of the National Rifle Association will open at Bisley Camp today and continue for two weeks, or until Saturday, July 22.

The programme for this year's meeting at Bisley shows a determined effort to attract more competition, particularly from those of the younger generation.

The prize lists for the meeting generally have been lengthened and equalized and entrance fees in many instances have also been reduced.
