Further Skyward Tendencies in The Hardware Market

(Hardware and Metal, July 12.)

Numerous changes are again the order of the week's hardware markets and some of the revisions made are most important. One of the outstanding changes is that which has been made on shovels, spades and coops, the new discounts named providing for a decline of about 10 per cent. in these lines. Another im-

portant announcement made by the manufacturers of these is that half polished and full polished finishes will again be available at the usual net extra.

In line with the strength shown in the metal market on copper, manufacturers have responded and copper wash boilers, tea kettles, tea and coffee pots have all undergone revision upward, the advance amounting to a straight 10 per cent. Copper rivets have gone to higher levels also this week.

Lined oil is again featured in the changes which have taken place, prices going up from twenty to thirty cents a gallon, and in one instance fifty cents a gallon. This is a direct reflection of the
