The report of the commissioner of finance recommending the usual monthly payments was adopted. A letter was read from the New Brunswick Power Company in regard to the protest of the city against increased lighting rates. The letter was received and filed. Mr. Frink gave notice that he would introduce a motion at the next meeting of the council regarding the development of areas within the city. A motion by Commissioner Bullock regarding the extension of grain conveyors to the government berths was carried. Representations will be made to Ottawa in this respect.
