CANADIAN TRADE AT AMERICAN PORTS
During the fiscal year which ended June 30th, 1888, the Canadian in transit trade at American ports reached the value of \$23,664,475, of which \$8,342,817 consisted of goods going from Canada to other countries, and \$15,321,658 of goods coming from other countries to Canada.

NOTICE
The preamble of the act recites the fact that by the custom of merchants, a bill of lading being transferable by indorsement, the property in the goods may pass to the indorsee, but all rights in respect of the contract continue in the original shipper or owner, and it frequently happens that goods, in respect to which bills of lading purport to have been signed, have not been laden on board. It then goes on to enact, that every consignee of goods named in a bill of lading, and every indorsee of a bill of lading to whom property in the goods may pass by consignee or indorsement, shall be treated with all such rights of action, and subject to all such liabilities with respect to such goods, as if the contract in the bill of lading had been made with himself.
