THE "WHITE LADY OF THE HOHENZOLLERN" ONCE MORE

Everybody has heard of the "White Lady," who is said always to make her ghostly appearance in the old palace at Berlin whenever death is about to overtake a member of the reigning house of Prussia, and concerning whose visitation on the eve of the demise of Frederick the Great Carlyle wrote so interestingly in his history of that monarch. The White Lady is supposed to be the spectre of Countess Agnes of Meran, whose first husband was Count Olymunde, whom she murdered, along with the two children she had borne him, because they constituted an obstacle to her marriage with one of the ancestors of the Kaiser.

It is related that, although she succeeded in accomplishing her ambition, she became an object of such execration by the people of Berlin that on the death of her second husband she was obliged to fly for her life, and seek refuge in Southern Germany. According to tradition, she died in the little Bavarian town of Himmelskron, not very far from Bamberg, but her tomb has been sought in vain in the churchyard and in the church itself.

Recent building operations in connection with the strengthening of the foundations of the ancient church of Himmelskron have led to the discovery, hidden away beneath a pile of stones in the vaults of the church, of a leaden coffin, the remaining marks of which served to indicate that it contained the remains of a lady of the house of Hohenzollern, this being confirmed by the fact that when the coffin was opened and examined there were found the skeleton of a woman and the remains of gold-embroidered robes.

Close by this coffin there were two smaller ones, holding the skeletons of children. While there is every reason, therefore, to believe that the remains in the larger coffin were those of the White Lady of the house of Hohenzollern, speculation prevails as to whether or not the smaller ones were the offspring of the countess' first marriage, and who met with death at her hands, or whether they were the issue of her union with the prince, to whom she had perpetrated such frightful crimes.

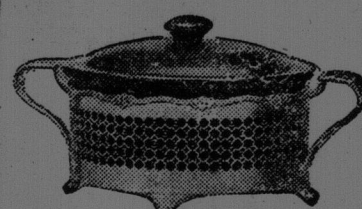
From the location of the coffins it would seem as if they had been thrust on one side, without any ceremony, in order to await the decision of the highest ecclesiastical authorities as to whether they were entitled to Christian burial and the rites of the church, and had then been forgotten. Perhaps if they are now, after all these hundreds of years, interred with the blessing of the church in consecrated ground, the ghost of the White Lady that haunts the old palace at Berlin may be laid.

It is a matter of popular superstition that when "ghosts walk," it is because their remains do not lie properly buried. If the White Lady is finally laid to rest with the blessing of the church, with the rites, which have hitherto been denied to her remains, possibly she, too, will cease to haunt the Hohenzollerns.

Of course many people scoff at the existence of ghosts in general, and of the White Lady of the Hohenzollerns in particular. But the late Emperor Frederick, the most matter of fact and least imaginative prince of his line, was particularly interested in the subject, and collected all the evidence he could about it, for the purpose of depositing it in the archives of his family.

Perhaps the most important testimony in this connection consists of the sworn statements signed by Prince Ferdinand of Prussia, and a number of his fellow-officers, to all of whom the White Lady is declared to have appeared as they sat together on the eve of the prince's death at the battle of Salsfeld in 1866.

Moreover, Thomas Carlyle went to no little trouble to procure evidence, when writing the history of Frederick the Great, that the White Lady had appeared to that famous monarch on the eve of his death. The king, so Carlyle relates, was on the road to recovery from his illness when suddenly one morning he declared that he had seen the white-clad spectre during the night, that his hour had come, and that it was useless to ward off death any longer. So he refused to take any further medicine or nourishment, turned his face to the wall and died.
