

Elizabeth E., dau. of David Archibald, Esq., of Truro, N.S., A.D. 1816. He (Hugh McDonald) represented the County of 'Guysboro' for two sessions in the Local Legislature. Held the offices of Judge of Probate, Postmaster, Registrar of Deeds, etc., etc., for a number of years, and died A.D. 1877, aged 88 years. B. 30 Sept. 1818, in Sherbrooke, County of Guysboro'. Ed. at Sherbrooke Grammar School. M., November 1845, at Truro, Rebecca, third dau. of the late Samuel Archibald, Esq. (and sister of the present Governor Archibald), who died Sept. 1870. M. again in Truro, Oct. 1873, to Sarah, youngest dau. of the late Edward S. Blanchard, Esq., of that place, and sister of the High Sheriff of the Co. of Colchester, and Judge Blanchard, of King's Co., N.S. Held the offices of Comptroller of Customs, Collector of Excise and Surveyor of Shipping for a number of years, but resigned on account of becoming an importer and a candidate. First returned at last g.e. A Liberal Conservative.—*Sherbrooke, Guysboro' Co., N.S.*

McDONALD, Hon. JAMES STAINFORTH. (*Kings.*)

B. 3 Oct. 1839, at East Point, P.E.I. M. at Wolfville, N.S., 12 Jan. 1870, Miss Alice Sarah Young. Apptd. a member of the Executive Council of N.S., 22 Oct. 1878. Returned to the Local Legislature of N.S. for the first time at last g.e. A Liberal Conservative.—*Wolfville, Horton, King's Co., N.S.*

McDOUGALL, Hon. HECTOR F., J.P. (*Cape Breton.*)

S. of Malcolm McDougall, merchant, of Christmas Island, and Mary McNeil. B. at Christmas Island, C.B., 6 June 1848. Ed. there. M. at Arichat, C.B., 6 September 1875, by the Rt. Rev. John Cam-ron, D.D., Bishop of Arichat, to Christina, dau. of Allan Cam-ron and Catharine McGillivray, of Antigonish, N.S. Has been a Justice of the Peace since 1873. First returned to Legislature at last g.e., and appointed mem. of the Ex. Council of N.S. on 22 Oct. 1878. A Conservative.—*Christmas Island, C.B., N.S.*

McGRAY, NEHEMIAH DOANE. (*Shelburne.*)

Ancestors came from Ireland and settled in the State of Maine, whence they removed to Nova Scotia. S. of the late Asa McGray, Esq., by Eliza Ann, dau. of the late Nehemiah Doane, Esq. B. 29
