39. (1) All suits or actions under this Act, except Trial of administrative fines, and all prosecutions for contraventions suits, and of this Act which are not herein declared to be indictable prosecutions. offences, shall be tried before one or more justices of the peace, or before the recorder, police magistrate or stipendiary magistrate having jurisdiction where the cause of action arose or where the offence was committed, and the provisions of Part XV of the Criminal Code shall apply to all such suits and actions.

(2) In any case where a fine, or imprisonment and a Additional fine, is imposed under the provisions of this Act, the sentence penalty if fine not paid. may adjudge a term of imprisonment or a further term of imprisonment not exceeding in any case two months, to be served by the offender if such fine is not paid.

40. All pecuniary penalties and revenues from other Payments sources under this Act shall be paid into and form part into Consolidated of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of Canada.

Fund.

41. Notwithstanding any provision of this Act or any Chinese order or regulation made thereunder, any person of Chinese en route to Canada may origin or descent who is at the date of the coming into be admitted force of this Act en route to Canada and presents himself within three months if for admission within three months from said date, shall if head tax admissible under the provisions of the Chinese Immigration paid. Act or any amendment thereof, be permitted to enter Canada upon payment of the head tax therein provided: Provided that if he belongs to any of the exempt classes Proviso. he may be admitted exempt from the head tax.

42. Where any fine is imposed upon the owner or master No clearance of any vessel under any provision of this Act, such vessel of vessel until fine shall not be granted clearance until such fine is paid, paid, except except upon deposit with the Controller of a sum sufficient upon deposit. to cover such fine.

REPEAL.

43. Chapter ninety-five of the Revised Statutes of Repeal. Canada, 1906, chapter fourteen of the statutes of 1908, chapter seven of the statutes of 1917 and chapter twenty-one of the statutes of 1921, are hereby repealed.
