

shall at any time refuse or neglect to comply with any of the requirements of this Act, it shall be lawful for the Governor of this Province by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council thereof, upon complaint to that effect by any person or persons interested therein, to make any appointment or to do any other act, matter or thing which the said Quebec Board of Examiners for Stevedores ought to have made or done.

XXII. And be it enacted, That the term "Governor," wherever the same occurs in this Act, shall be held to comprehend the person administering the Government of this Province for the time being; and the terms "ship and vessel" shall embrace every ship or vessel of whatever kind or class, of and exceeding the burthen of one hundred and fifty tons, trading to or from this Province or to or from any parts beyond the limits thereof.
