the faid Certificate; and if any Rum or other Spirits shall be imported or found on board any such Ship or Vessel for which no such Certificate shall be produced, or which shall not agree therewith, the same shall be deemed and taken to be Foreign Rum and Spirits, and shall be subject and liable to the same Duties, Restrictions, Regulations, Penalties, and Forseitures in all Respects, as Rum or other Spirits of the Produce or Manufacture of any Foreign Colony or Plantation would be subject and liable to by Law.
