In further reference to your letter of the 20th Ultimo, reporting on the application of the Indians of the Way-way-see-cappo's Band No 62, that a part of sec 24 Township 20 24 west of the first meridian, be set apart as a fishing station for them in exchange for an equal area of land to be surrendered from their Reserve; I beg state that by Order in Council His Excellency, in virtue of the provisions of sub-section a of section 90 of the Dominion Lands Act, Chapter 54 of the Revised Statutes of Canada and by and with the advice of the Queen's Privy Council for Canada, is pleased to order that such part of section 24, Township 20, Range ^{24.} West of the 1st. Meridian, as does not form part of the Lake referred to, shall be, and the same is ^{by O.C. 4619th-94} hereby set apart as a fishing station for the Indians of the Way-way-see-cappo Band.
