

Ottawa, April 6th, 1936.

Sir:-

With reference to the work performed on the Pagan Indian Reserve in constructing dams and doing road work at an outlay of \$760.30, I beg to advise you that this expenditure has now been authorized and an accountable advance for the amount is being sent to you under separate cover.

I understand that the money has been expended in wages and material, the wages having been paid in the way of supplies. It will be necessary for you to submit receipted itemized accounts for the material purchased. It will also be necessary for you to submit receipted paylists in triplicate, showing the wages earned by each Indian. These returns should be accompanied by itemized accounts from the merchants showing what each Indian received in lieu of wages.

An early accounting of this advance should be made and I trust that full details will be furnished so that the vouchers and labour returns can be accepted by the Auditor.
