



Ottawa, 26th May, 1904.

Sir:-

I beg to refer to your letter of 10th February last recommending that a resident of North Temeconingue be appointed as a police constable, and to inform you that: the utility of making such an appointment seems to the Department to depend upon the manner in which offenders who might be detected and charged by him, would be dealt with, it does not feel that it is in a position to consider the question intelligently until reply shall have been received to the letter addressed to you on 26th ultimo requesting a report upon various cases therein enumerated.
