Ottawa .10th May, 1906.

In reply to your letter of the 7th instant, respecting bulls to be supplied by Mr Jas. Bairdof Pilot Mound, I beg to say that the price allowed does not include cost of transport. With proper care the bulls should not suffer when being transported from Pilot Mound to the reserves. This has been the Department's experience elsewhere. You should carry out your instructions.
